

## **Docomomo US National Symposium Student and Emerging Professional Scholarship Program Application Form**

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis from February 22 through May 2, 2022.

Thanks to the generous support of our Symposium sponsors, Docomomo US is pleased to offer student and emerging professional scholarships to participate in the 2022 National Symposium, Yo! Modernism: The View from Philadelphia, taking place May 31-June 5, 2022. Scholarships will cover the cost of Symposium registration, which includes opening and closing receptions, the keynote, and all sessions taking place Wednesday June 1 – Friday June 4, 2022. Tours and the Tuesday Hassrick House event are additional.

### **Eligibility**

Docomomo US Symposium Scholarships are available to anyone who meets the following criteria:

- Enrolled in an American undergraduate or graduate program or graduated in the last five (5) years in one of the following areas: architecture, landscape architecture, historic preservation, architectural history, or planning OR
- Graduated in the last five (5) years in any field and is currently employed in a preservation-related field
- Currently living in the United States of America

### **Application Requirements**

To be considered, applicants must:

- Complete the attached scholarship application
- Provide a copy of current school identification or graduation certificate

### **Criteria**

The Docomomo US Symposium Scholarship committee will score applications based on the following:

- Responses to open-ended questions
- Demonstrated interest in the preservation of modern architecture, landscapes, or design

In awarding the scholarships, preference will be given (as applicable) to:

- Applicants from diverse backgrounds or in under-represented groups
- Applicants who have engaged with Docomomo US or Docomomo US chapter programs

### **Notification**

Scholarship applicants will be notified via email on a rolling basis beginning April 4, 2022. Applicants should wait to register for the Symposium until being notified of the committee's decision.
