



Cape Cod Two-Day Excursion

Docomomo US Mass Modernism Tour
October 2, 2021 - October 3, 2021

From the 1930s to the 1970s, modernist architecture thrived in New England. Despite economic problems and a conservative culture, the region fostered the practices of Bauhaus refugees and their students. Join Docomomo US for a two-day excursion examining the experimental weekend houses they designed for themselves and clients on Cape Cod.

Mass Modernism will be led by **Timothy M. Rohan**. In Cape Cod, the Mass Modernism tour will be lead by **Peter McMahon**, the Founding Director of the Cape Cod Modern House Trust whose mission is to archive, restore and celebrate the Outer Cape's outstanding modern architecture and the creative culture that surrounded it. He is co-author, along with Christine Cipriani, of *Cape Cod Modern. Mid-Century Architecture and Community on the Outer Cape*, (2014, Metropolis Books) winner of the Historic New England Book Prize, 2015.



SCHEDULE

The two-day tour to the Cape will include a number of house visits including:

Wellfleet

- The Kepes House by Marcel Breuer from 1949
- The Kugel/Kips House by Charlie Zehnder from 1970
- The Hatch Cottage by Jack Hall from 1960
- Chermayeff House and Studio from 1944-1960s
- The Breuer Cottage (his final resting place) from 1949/62/67
- The Weidlinger House by Paul Weidlinger and built in 1953
- The Lechay House designed by Hayden Walling from 1959
- Chapel of St. James the Fisherman designed by Olav Hammarstrom in 1957

Truro

- The Brodeur House design by Charlie Zehnder in 1977
- The Mark House designed by Paul Krueger in 1966

Provincetown

- The Mushroom House by Donald Jasinski from 1953
- The Murchison House by Gropius and TAC from 1957-59 (tentative)
- The Bultman House and Studio by Tony Smith 1945 (tentative)

Two beach picnics and an evening sunset dinner are included.

Before we say goodbye to the Cape, the group is invited to join us for visit a to the Scott House by Marcel Breuer in Dennis from 1948.
